Need To Restore Your License?

Registration will be open to the first **150** citizens with a license that has been revoked, suspended or canceled. The goal of the clinic is to provide “one-stop shopping” for citizens to interact with the appropriate agencies, so the individual may regain driving privileges.

Examples of why a driver's licenses may be suspended:

- failure to maintain automobile insurance
- failure to have a valid vehicle registration
- designation as an habitual traffic offender
- failure to obtain, renew, or return a car tag
- failure to pay traffic tickets or child support
- the accumulation of too many points on one's driving record
- failure to pay or work off fines, fees, and costs imposed as part of a criminal sentence
- a consequence of entering a plea to certain crimes

The clinic cannot help with the following.

- WALK-INS are not eligible to attend.
- Pending criminal charges (not related to your driver's license).
- A driver's license that was revoked, suspended, or cancelled due to out-of-county matters.

Disqualifying Offenses:

- Active suspension for DUI
- Suspensions for Felony Drug Charges
