

Beginning July 1, 2021, the Clerk of Circuit Court is required by law to make the identity of each respondent against whom a final judgment for an injunction for protection of a minor under s. 741.30, s. 784.046, or s. 784.0485 is entered, as well as the fact that a final judgment for an injunction for the protection of a minor under s. 741.30, s. 784.046, or s. 784.0485 has been entered against that respondent. This information must be publicly available on an Internet website unless the respondent is a minor.

This information is available by selecting ONLINE SERVICES, SEARCH OFFICIAL RECORDS on [www.okaloosaclerk.com](http://www.okaloosaclerk.com). Select "Document", then select the document type, "Final Judgment of Injunction for Protection of a Minor" in the document dropdown list. Chose the Date Range and the Number of Records to display. A list will be returned including the names of the Grantees. These grantees are the names of respondents against whom a final judgment for an injunction for protection of a minor has been entered. Please be aware that many individuals may share the same name.

Any affected party may request that the information specified above regarding a Final Judgment of Injunction for Protection of a Minor that is not available on the publicly available internet web site before July 1, 2021 be made available on the internet website unless the respondent is a minor. Such request must be in writing and delivered by mail, facsimile, or electronic transmission or in person to the Clerk of Court. The request must specify the case number assigned to a Final Judgment for an Injunction for Protection of a Minor under s. 741.30, s. 784.046, or s. 784.045. A fee may not be charged pursuant to such request.
